

# **General Information**

When should campers arrive? Check-in begins at 2:30 p.m. on Monday. The camp program begins at 5:00 p.m.

#### When does camp end?

Junior/Leadership: after breakfast **Friday** (8:30 a.m.) Teen: after breakfast Saturday (8:30 a.m.)

**Reminders of what to bring**... See the packing list <u>(link)</u> for specific guidelines about what to bring and what not to bring. Campers participating in the 10:45 Leadership programs should bring some extra money for laundry over the weekend.

#### Medications

Any medications must be in original containers. All camper medication must be turned in to our health assistants at check-in. Only our health staff is allowed to administer medication. Our health center stocks basic over-the-counter medications (Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Benadryl, etc.) and first aid supplies. It is not necessary to send these unless your child needs them on a regular basis. Rescue inhalers and Epi-pens are checked at the health services office, but campers are asked to keep these with them at all times.

#### **Illness Policy**

The health and safety of each guest is a priority at Grand View. We ask that all guests staying at the camp arrive healthy. If a camper has experienced any illness with symptoms of fever, vomiting or diarrhea, they must be symptom free without medication for 48 hours prior to staying at camp. This will help limit the possibility of the spread of illness to other guests at camp. We are happy to refund or transfer registration payments to another week of camp should a camper be unable attend due to illness.

#### Meals

Those on special diets must bring their own necessary supplements. Please contact Rachael Wilson (<u>rwilson@grandviewcamp.org</u>) if you have questions about our camp menu. We are pleased to offer gluten-free substitutions for main dish items for campers with dietary restrictions.

#### Phone Access

Phones may only be accessed by campers for emergencies.

As a Christian organization, Grand View Camp maintains high standards of conduct. Campers who use alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs will be dismissed. No romantic contact is allowed. Uncooperative or noncompliant campers are subject to dismissal.

#### Updating Camper Information

From Hwy 60, turn South onto South Mountain Avenue (this will become Main Street in Eagar) and drive approximately 2.5 miles until it takes a hard right. Turn left (South) on Water Canyon Road (also NF285-turns into a gravel road). Take Water Canyon approximately 5 miles South. You will see a sign for Grand View Camp. Take a left and follow this road for 2 miles. You will arrive at the camp.
